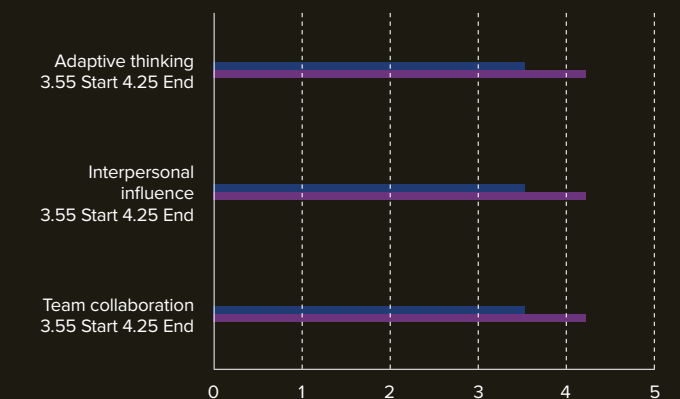
Executive development

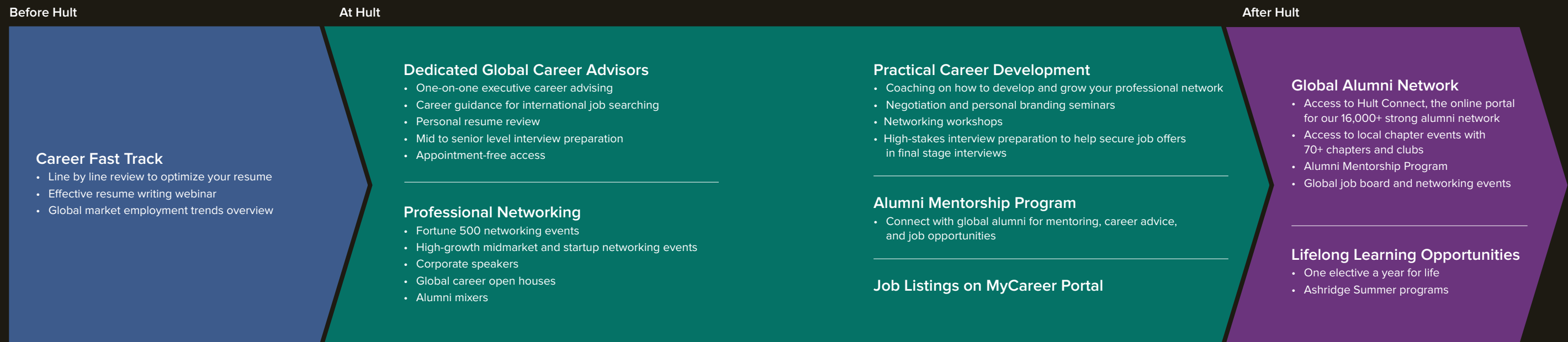


Networking the room like a rockstar

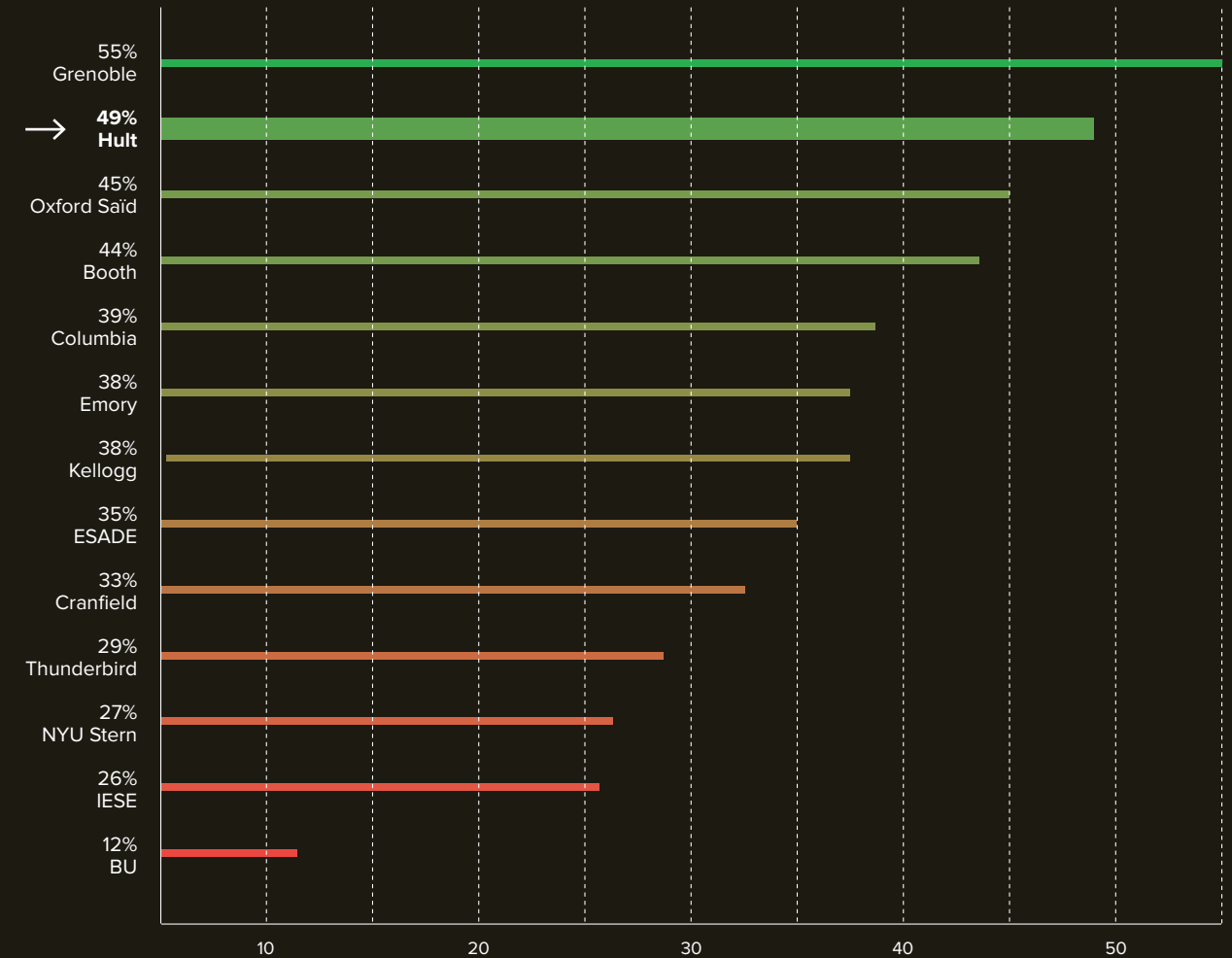

Cross sample of Executive MBA salary increases after one year (%)



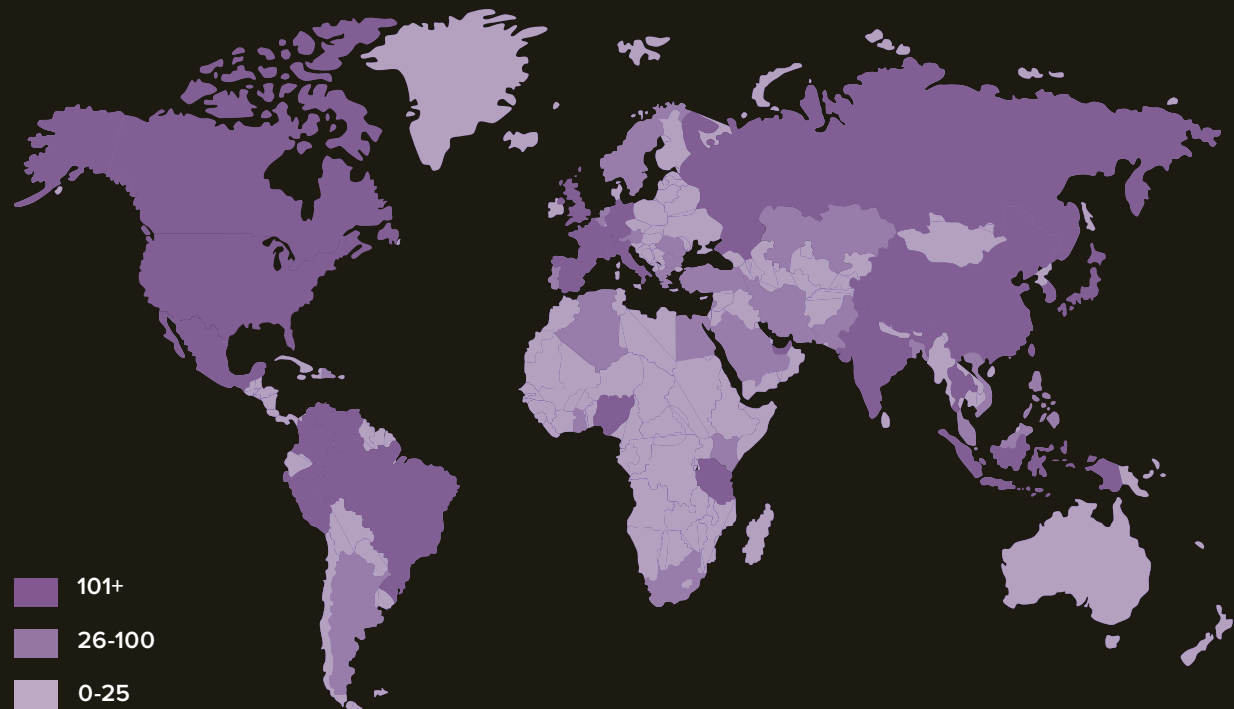
