STUDENT SERVICES.



OMNI College is committed to providing students with the highest level of support that will help maximize their chances of success. Some of the services offered include:

Employment assistance: Now more than ever before, employers are specifically looking to hire OMNI graduates. The College has built a solid reputation for being able to deliver job-ready nurses, as our working graduates have proven it's true. Job search workshops are held regularly at the College, providing

guidance to students on resume writing, interview questions, follow up tactics and job links.

Financial aid: OMNI College is designated by StudentAidBC, which means that financial assistance may be available to eligible students. There are also other possible financial assistance options such as low-interest bank loans for Canadian citizens, landed immigrants and permanent residents. Other financial options may also be provided for international students.

Personal advising: Students have access to the College's Founder, Mr. Ron Burke R.N., who has been advising students through their journey to become health care workers in Canada since the College was founded in 1999. OMNI Advisors & Student Success Coordinators are also always available on campus for guidance and support.

Onsite access to qualified immigration consulting services: International students have been coming to OMNI College from all parts of the world for a very long time, and over the years we have seen our applicants experience a very high visa approval rate. We have a licensed Regulated Canadian Immigration Consultant on staff at OMNI who can assist our students navigate through complex immigration processes, including study permit applications, file review, permit extensions and also permanent residency application processing for those students who wish to remain in Canada after graduation. These extra services are optional for each student and available on campus.

Free high-speed Internet: All students have access to our computer lab which is fully-equipped and connected to high-speed Internet, student printer, copier and scanner. Wireless Internet is also available throughout the campus.

Medical insurance: Students qualify for special reduced rates for medical insurance.

For Internationally Educated Nurses

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

If you are an IEN wanting to become a Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse in Canada, the Canadian Nursing Review Program can provide you with the skills required to meet Canadian standards and language in preparation of achieving your nursing license.

The Program is made up of 6 main components:

- 1. Medical Terminology & Communication
- 2. CELBAN Test Preparation
- 3. Canadian Nursing Review (includes a clinical experience)
- 4. Final Clinical Competencies Review & Nurse Licensing Exam Prep (NCLEX-RN or CPNRE)
- 5. The Co-Op Education Work Experience
- 6. Leadership in Nursing

Medical Terminology & Communication covers vocabulary, reading, writing, conversation and pronunciation, abbreviations and terminology used in nursing in North America. **CELBAN Test Prep** helps students maximize their English competency test score which is required for Nurse registration in Canada. CELBAN is currently one of the only English tests recognized as proof of language proficiency by all Canadian Nursing regulators across the country.

The Canadian Nursing Review, Clinical Competencies and Nurse Licensing Exam Prep courses teach skill-development, critical-thinking training for nursing judgments, test question approach strategies and cultural awareness. Students have the opportunity to develop their practical experience during on-site laboratory sessions, case-study simulations, and during a clinical experience at a local health care facility, to ensure they can be well prepared for safe and effective practice in the workplace.

The Co-Op Work Experience is an essential component of the program. Students have the opportunity to complete a co-op work experience at a Canadian hospital or health care facility. Nursing procedures vary from country to country, so the work experience offers invaluable training in nursing in a North American health care environment.

Leadership in Nursing equips students with much needed entry-level leadership and management skills.

Once completed, successful graduates of this program will be much more confident about working in the Canadian health care environment.

*CPNRE = Canadian Practical Nurse Registration Examination

CELBAN = Canadian English Language Benchmarks Assessment for Nurses

WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT TO ACHIEVE:

- Successful qualification as a Canadian Registered Nurse (RN) or Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)
- A passing grade on an English competency test (ie. CELBAN, IELTS) that is recognized by a Canadian nursing regulatory body
- A favorable result on your clinical competency assessment (SEC, OSCE, NCAS)
- Greater knowledge, skills and confidence
- Gainful employment as a Nurse in Canada
- An increased quality of life

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Must be registered as an RN in country of origin
- Minimum CELBAN score of 6, OR IELTS score of 5.5, OR equivalent
- Pass an interview with an OMNI advisor
- Have a minimum of 1125 hours of nursing experience within the last 4 years

Following the start of their program, and prior to the clinical experience component of their program, students must also provide a clear criminal background check, current CPR certification, and evidence of up-to-date immunizations as required by clinical sites.

Canadian Nursing Review

For Internationally Educated Nurses—— ADVANCED

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Advanced program was designed for those nurses who have a higher level of English competency and do not need the language and medical terminology training.

If you are an IEN wanting to become a Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse in Canada and you have a minimum IELTS 6.5 overall or equivalent, then the Canadian Nursing Review—Advanced is the right program for you.

The Program is made up of 4 main components:

- 1) Canadian Nursing Review (includes a clinical experience)
- 2) Final Clinical Competencies Review & Nurse Licensing Exam Prep (NCLEX-RN or CPNRE)
- 3) The Co-Op Education Work Experience
- 4) Leadership in Nursing

Outcomes are identical to the Canadian Nursing Review program (please see the "What you can expect to Achieve" column on the preceding page).

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Must be registered as an RN in country of origin
- Have a minimum of 1125 hours of nursing experience or graduated from a basic nursing education program within the last 4 years
- Minimum IELTS 6.5 overall or equivalent
- Pass the OMNI Comprehensive Nursing Assessment
- Pass an interview with an OMNI advisor

Following the start of their program, and prior to the clinical experience component, students must also provide a clear criminal background check, current CPR certification, and evidence of up-to-date immunizations as required by clinical sites.

National Nursing Assessment Service (NNAS): The NNAS provides a streamlined assessment service for Internationally-Educated Nurses (IENs) interested in applying for nurse registration in Canada. All IENs must first apply through the NNAS.

After assessment by the NNAS, the applicable provincial nursing regulatory body may require further assessment or courses (in addition to the training provided by OMNI College), which may create delays in your process. All applicants to OMNI are interviewed by an OMNI Advisor, so we encourage all applicants to discuss their personal timing plan during their interview.

CELBAN Test Preparation

Canadian English Language Benchmarks Assessment for Nurses

WHAT IS CELBAN?

CELBAN stands for the Canadian English Language Benchmarks Assessment for Nurses. It is the first language assessment test designed specifically for Internationally-Educated Nurses.

Applicants for RN (Registered Nurse) or LPN (Licensed Practical Nurse) registration in Canada must demonstrate fluency in English. The CELBAN test has been approved by all the nurse licensing bodies in Canada as a measure to evaluate the applicant's proficiency in English.

The content of all tasks in the CELBAN test are based on data collected from the analysis of the English language demands of the nursing profession. To ensure accuracy, tasks were created by the test developers with input from nursing instructors and consultants.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The CELBAN Test Preparation course offered at OMNI College is for nonnative speakers of English at the upper-intermediate level of English proficiency who wish to improve their English skills in preparation to practice nursing in Canada. This course also helps Internationally-Educated Nurses prepare to write the CELBAN Test and maximize their test score.

The course focuses on improving a student's ability to actually **use** the language rather than to simply **know** the language. This concentrated focus enables our experienced instructors to teach you the quickest and most effective methods to improve your test score.

Our program focuses on activities which allow students to practice all the skills they are required to perform on the test. The focus is on intensive speech practice with emphasis on pronunciation accuracy and speech fluency.

How does it work?

CELBAN testing covers 4 components:

- 1. Listening
- 2. Reading
- 3. Writing
- 4. Speaking

The CELBAN listening, writing and reading assessments are administered as a group test totalling approximately 3 hours.

The CELBAN speaking assessment is administered individually and lasts approximately 20 to 30 minutes.

The minimum scores currently required in BC by the CRNBC is: speaking 8; listening 10; reading 8; and writing 7.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum IELTS 6.5 overall (min Speaking 6.0 and Writing 5.5) or equivalent
- Pass an interview with an OMNI advisor

IELTS Test Preparation

International English Language Testing System

WHAT IS IELTS?

IELTS stands for the International English Language Testing System. It is an assessment tool designed to assess the language ability of candidates, recognized as an official language proficiency test and used by more than 8,000 employers, college/university admissions departments, immigration authorities, government agencies, and professional bodies worldwide.

There are 2 versions of the IELTS tests: General IELTS and Academic IELTS.

Applicants for RN (Registered Nurse) or LPN (Licensed Practical Nurse) registration in Canada must demonstrate fluency in English. Just like CELBAN, the Academic IELTS test has also been approved by all the nurse licensing bodies in Canada as a measure to evaluate the applicant's proficiency in English.



COURSE DESCRIPTION

The IELTS Test Preparation course offered at OMNI College is for non-native speakers of English at the upper-intermediate level of English proficiency who wish to improve their English skills in preparation to practice nursing in Canada.

The course focuses on improving a candidate's ability to pass all 4 modules of the IELTS test: Listening, Reading, Writing, and Speaking.

This part-time course is conveniently scheduled in the evenings, so that those who work or take other courses during the day can still study IELTS and move ahead towards achieving their ultimate goals!

During OMNI's IELTS Test Preparation course, you will:

- ⇒ Become familiar with the format of the IELTS test
- ⇒ Practice your test taking abilities during weekly IELTS exam simulations, under timed conditions
- ⇒ Improve your ability in speed and accuracy
- ⇒ Review your own answers in comparison with model answers
- ⇒ Improve your test scores as compared to initial assessments

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Pass the OMNI English
 Assessment test OR have a previous minimum IELTS 6.5 overall score or equivalent
- Pass an interview with an OMNI advisor

Did You Know?

The minimum IELTS scores currently required by the nursing regulatory bodies in Canada are: Speaking 7; Listening 7.5 Reading 6.5; and Writing 7.

Medical Terminology & Communication

COURSE DESCRIPTION

OMNI's Medical Terminology & Communication course is designed for medical professionals who want to improve their communication within the health care workplace. The course focuses on improving language fluency by practicing listening, speaking, reading and writing tasks in the context of a Canadian health care setting.

Nurses, doctors, pharmacists, physical therapists, international health care students and other medical professionals where English is not their first language would be best suited for this course.

The course teaches not just terminology but also assists the student to apply the terminology and effectively communicate in an English-speaking workplace environment. Students who successfully complete the course will be able to:

- Identify all human anatomy-related terms
- Be able to communicate disorders and diseases
- Describe procedures for various emergencies
- Understand terms used in the context of psychiatry/mental health, and pharmacology
- Describe common workplace medications, treatments and their administration

Coursework includes in-class presentations, working on presentation skills (speaking clearly, using a loud voice, facial and body expressions, etc) and interpersonal communication skills.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Min 19 years of age or older
- IELTS 5.5 or equivalent, OR pass the OMNI English
 Assessment Test

18 weeks, full-time course.

HOW TO ENROL

ADMISSIONS POLICY

- OMNI College students must meet the minimum admissions requirements. Neither the institution nor the student can waive the requirements
- 2. Students must meet Canadian immigration entry requirements
- 3. Applicants are required to show proof of medical insurance (if you do not have medical insurance, you can purchase it through OMNI College)

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Step 1: Attend a free online Information Session by contacting Omni's Agent in your area. During this session, you will gain all the information you need to decide whether the programs at OMNI are the right fit for you.
- Step 2: Submit your completed enrolment application form, application fee, and the required supporting documents to your Agent (ie. proof of English scores, RN registration, etc.)
- Step 3: Complete an interview with an OMNI Advisor via Agent, and get answers to any last remaining questions you may have. Upon completion of your interview, and receipt of your application documentation and initial fees, you will receive a Conditional Letter of Acceptance detailing the total required fees due (including tuition, optional homestay fee, medical insurance, textbook/materials fee, etc).
- Step 4: Once payment of the required fees due is confirmed by OMNI College, you will receive your official Letter of Acceptance. Required fees must be paid no later than 30 days prior to the start of your program.

International students requiring a study permit should apply and settle the required fees well in advance, as the study permit application processing times vary from country to country, and may even take several months to process.
